

WMDA cares for donors who save patients' lives




• WMDA oversees global standards for unrelated HPC donations and the international exchange of HPC products.

- WMDA Accreditation has been achieved by many registries
- 75% of the donors listed in *Bone Marrow Donors Worldwide* are in WMDA-accredited registries.



2012: 19,265 HPC donations to 56 different countries





2012: 426 HPC donations were provided for unrelated patients in South America


Registries are responsible for coordination of the search and provisioning of **HPC Marrow**, **HPC Apheresis** and HPC Cord **Blood from** unrelated donors
