- Good basic labs: haematology, blood transfusion, chemistry, histopathology, microbiology
- Personnel trained in and infrastructure for pheresis
- Personnel trained in and infrastructure for cryopreservation and cell storage
- Good quality other medical specialities



# **Clinical requirements for allogeneic transplant**

- Personnel trained in and resources for administration of high dose chemotherapy and its complications
- ?Ability to deliver total body irradiation?
- Personnel trained in and physical environment for, management of febrile neutropenia
- Personnel trained in the management of short to midterm complications of alloSCT, principally infection and GvHD



#### Other hospital requirements for allogeneic transplant

- Good basic labs: haematology, blood transfusion, chemistry, histopathology, microbiology
- Provision of HLA typing results
- Personnel trained in and infrastructure for pheresis
- Personnel trained in and infrastructure for cryopreservation and cell storage
- Personnel trained in and infrastructure for BM harvest
- Good quality other medical specialities , particularly ITU
