# Statistical Course Haploidentical family donors with special respect to minors as donor

This workshop was jointly organized by the EBMT Donor Outcome Committee and the WBMT.

The donor outcome committee of the EBMT together with the WBMT offered this workshop to raise awareness for haploidentical donors with a special focus on minors, serving as related donors for sibling or adult relatives. The workshop was focused on expert knowledge on haploidentical transplantation in children and adults, practical management of stem cell collection in minors and ethical considerations, and offered the participants the opportunity to interact with the speakers and discuss their current praxis. To reach these goals, the Faculty comprised a multidisciplinary team of experts in transplantations and in ethical questions.
